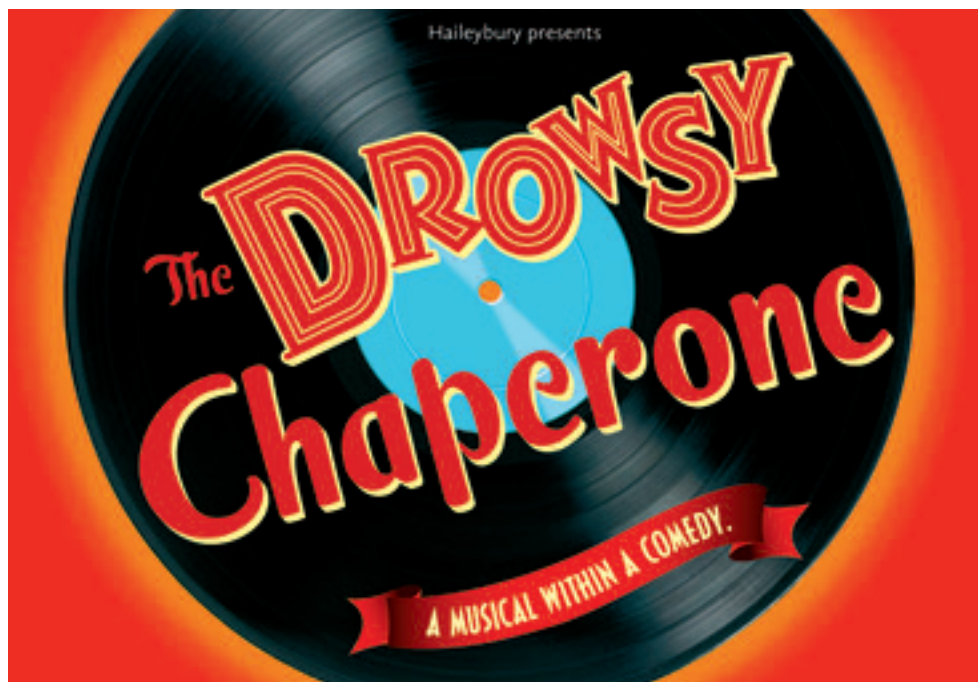
The Drowsy Chaperone

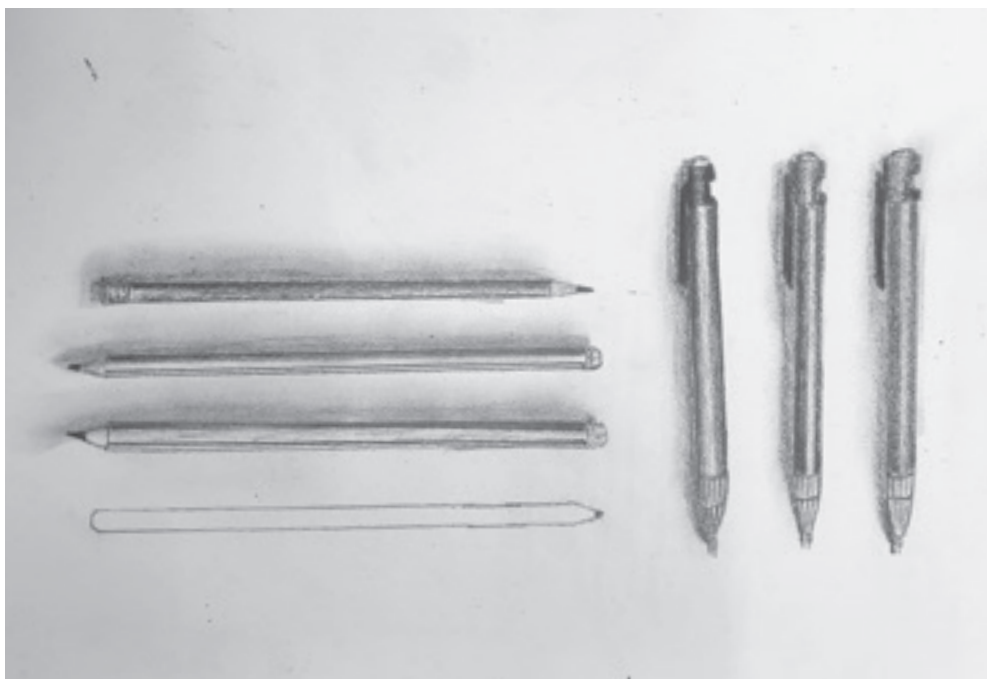

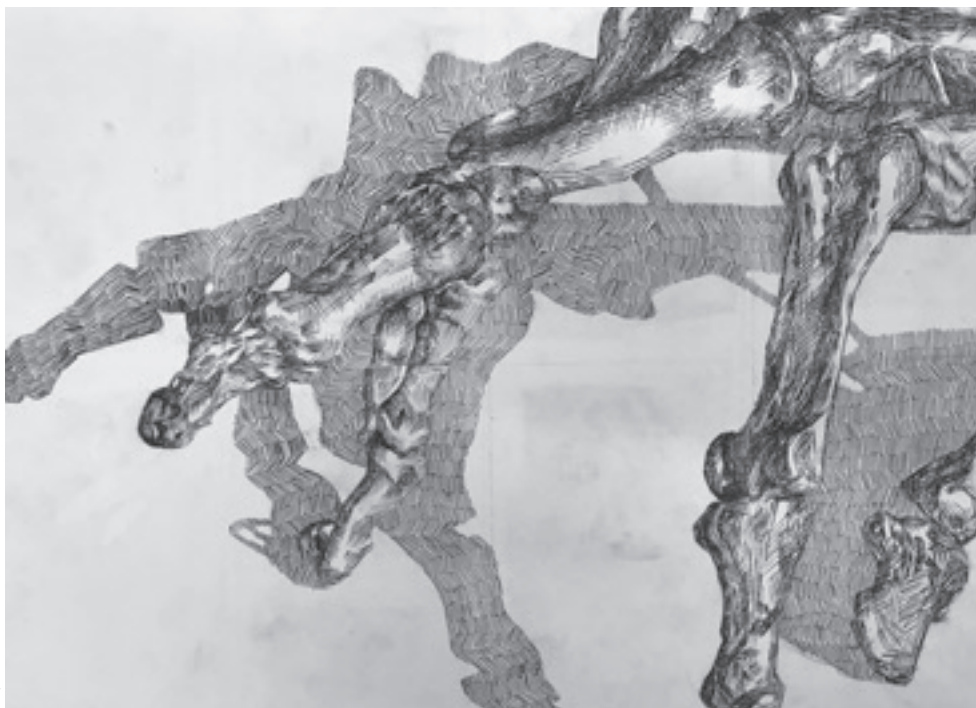
