Overseas customers may prefer to have their order delivered direct to Haileybury. If you require delivery to the school, please ensure that the following details are provided in the shipping details:

The delivery is addressed to the child who will be attending the school

The first line of the shipping address includes the name of the child's boarding house.

Please order as soon as possible giving yourself plenty of time to receive your order and check it is a suitable size ready for the start of term. To ensure you have everything you need for the start of term, **we strongly recommend that you place your order before the end of July 2022.**

Please be prepared...

As soon as your order arrives, **try everything on your child**, then try it on again in mid-August. If your child has grown more than expected, please order an alternative size online and return the unworn item(s) for a refund.

Not keen on sewing? To make life easier we offer a **name tape sew in service**; select this option to ensure your child's uniform arrives fully named, ready to wear and harder to lose. Please note this service is **NOT** available for orders placed between 13th August and 12th September. Embroidered name tapes are available to order throughout the year.

How to order

New pupil appointments

Whilst it is not essential, if you need a personal fitting service for your child, you can arrange an appointment to visit the Uniform Shop at Haileybury or the Perry showroom in London. Second-hand uniform

Parents are responsible for ensuring that any uniform purchased conforms to the School's uniform regulations. Hair

For all Year Groups, hair must be clean, tidy, of natural colour and of reasonable length and sensible, non-extreme style. Girls' hair beyond collar length must be tied back when in uniform or sports kit. Boys' hair should be minimum grade 2.5, be off the collar and not tied back.

Lower School uniform

General

Clothing should be clean and in good repair.

Glasses

Glasses should have shatterproof lenses which are suitable for playing sports, or specific sports glasses should be used. Smart glasses are not permitted.

Jewellery

Jewellery may not be worn except:

- 1 fine gold or silver chain with a small hanging pendant
- 1 pair of discrete gold or silver ear studs in the ear lobes (girls only)
- 1 wristwatch

All of the above must be removed for games/PE

Casual dress

After lessons, or 4.30 pm, whichever is the later, pupils may wear casual clothes but they are still expected to look tidy and presentable and should not wear mixed dress. Casual clothes may also be worn at the weekends from 11.30 am on Saturdays except for formal School events. Casual clothes may be worn on trips out of School (e.g. to theatres etc.). Pupils should dress appropriately for the destination of the trip and respect the instructions given by the supervising staff. Day pupils must arrive at School each day in school wear.

Sports equipment

Equipment is provided for all sports although those playing in teams may prefer to purchase their own. If you are unsure of any aspect of the games kit, please email the Director of Sport, Andy Searson a.searson@haileybury.com

Name-taping

All uniform and sports kit must be named. Perry provides embroidered name tapes and a sew-in service for orders placed before 14 August each year.

When ordering name tapes parents need to provide the House initials as well as the pupil's name which should appear in the following format.

Jewellery

Jewellery may not be worn except:

- 1 pair of discrete gold or silver ear studs in the ear lobes (girls only)
- 1 wristwatch
- 1 unostentatious ring (Sixth Form only)

Jewellery must be removed for games/PE.

Pupils should dress appropriately for the destination of the trip and respect the instructions given by the supervising staff. Day pupils must arrive at School each day in school wear. In addition, the following points of style should be noted:

- CPs may wear their own choice of suit skirt or trouser and a black or navy V-necked unbranded sweater. Suits must be plain, business-like and dark blue, dark grey or black
- Insignia that indicate prefect status, scholar status, sports colours, or House membership may be worn on any day. Other approved insignia may only be worn at weekends
- CPs may use a Haileybury CP umbrella and CP scarf.

- 6 Haileybury Sixth Form shirts (navy/white stripe or chambray or pink or white). Shirts can be any combination of short or long-sleeved.
- 2 House ties.

Compulsory regulation uniform available from a retailer of your choice

- 8 pairs socks (plain, dark blue, or black)
- 2 pairs plain black leather school shoes (no suede, canvas, plimsolls, trainers, moccasins, boot styles or Vans)
- 1 plain black or navy overcoat or waterproof. Coats with ostentatious/furry hoods are not permitted. The School's heavyweight winter sports jacket can also be worn as a school coat.

Additional recommended clothing for Sixth Form available from a retailer of your choice

Every term there are Sixth Form events in School or in House where the dress code is Black Tie. You may wish to purchase this for your child or else they can wear their school uniform. Black Tie would involve: Black dinner jacket (sometimes called a tuxedo) and trousers with silk/satin covered lapels, either single or double breasted; white evening shirt (turn down collar, either Marcella or pleated front); black self-tie bow tie (they will be taught to tie them in Houses); cummerbund or waistcoat optional.

It is recommended they have 1 tuckbox (lockable and named) not to exceed 55 x 40 x 35 cm.

Casual Dress

After lessons, or after 3.30pm on days when there are no afternoon lessons, pupils may wear casual clothes but they are still expected to look tidy and presentable and should not wear mixed dress. Casual clothes may also be worn at the weekends from 3.30 pm on Saturdays and, except for formal School events. Casual clothes may be worn for trips out of
