



Additional Charges for the Academic Year 2023-24

1. Music

- a. Individual music lessons will be charged at £320 per block of 10 x 30 minute lessons for each subject or instrument. Extended lessons (where appropriate) will be charged on a pro-rata basis. A year's tuition will normally involve 30 lessons. However, because of exams during the Summer term, pupils in the Fifts and Upper Sixth will normally only be taught and thus charged for 25 lessons.

All music lessons are timetabled in blocks of 10. Notice to terminate tuition from the end of a lesson block must be given by the specified date, in writing, to the Director of Music (email music@haileybury.com). Notice deadlines for the 2023-24 academic year are:

31 October (to stop after 10 lessons, at or around the end of November);

31 January (to stop after 20 lessons, two or three weeks after half term); and

31 May (to stop at the end of the academic year).

Once due notice has been given it is also possible to instruct in writing (a) for the timetabling of lessons to cease immediately, the remaining lessons in the block thus being forfeited or (b) for tuition to be extended to the next end-of-term point, for example to complete preparation for a music exam.

A change at a parent's request from one teacher to another of the same instrument is considered to be a cancellation followed by a re-start of lessons, and thus the same conditions apply.

- b. £60 is charged per term for hire of each musical instrument.
- c. Free instrumental tuition may be available on a trial basis for 10 lessons. Please refer to the music application form on the website for further details.
- d. All pupils are encouraged to participate and receive instruction in the various instrumental and choral ensembles for which no additional charges are made.
- e. Parents are reminded of the importance of ensuring that instruments (whether owned or hired) are covered by insurance. Please note that not all household policies provide this cover.

2. Minor Sports

Rowing and Sailing Up to £75 per term

Golf A charge will be levied toward corporate club membership and green fees.

3. Dance Lessons

£80 per class per term. Half a term's notice is required to cancel.

4. Rates for LAMDA

LAMDA lessons will be available at the rates detailed below. Further details and an application form will follow.

5. Overnight Stays

Overnight stays will be charged at the rate of £70 per night.

6. Transport

Costs are charged termly in arrears and normally updated for the start of each academic year. A note of charges for 2023-24 will be sent directly to parents of pupils using the service. Charges for the various routes we offer are available from our Deputy Estate Director (Simon Brophy – s.brophy@haileybury.com).

7. House Subs

Every House member (including Lower School members) pays a contribution towards those expenses for which the House is responsible, such as recreational equipment and House activities. The sum is £17 per term, and this is collected via the termly invoice.

8. Miscellaneous

As well as the charges listed above, there may be other charges added to termly invoices which would include:

- Public examination fees
- Taxi (and chaperones where necessary) for offsite treatments and appointments
- Private tuition
- Course books in Sixth Form only

9. Learning Support

A fee of £250 is charged for formal assessments.

10. Flexible Boarding

Lower School pupils boarding regularly for one or more specified nights will be charged at the rate of £540 per term for each night per week that they board.
